We know that we are supposed to have faith, but what exactly does "faith" look like? The Bible says that faith "makes us sure of what we hoped for and gives us proof of what we cannot see" (Hebrews 11:1). What does that mean? Do you know that you use faith every day in your life? When you sit in a chair, you have faith that the legs won't break. You don't always see the legs before you sit. They could be broken, but you have faith that they will hold you.

We can't always trust cars or chairs, but we can always trust God and His Word. We don't see God, but we have faith that He is there and He won't let us down. That's why you can do great things.

**Your Challenge:** This week's challenge is to find three examples where you use faith. This will help you to understand what faith is and what faith looks like. Ask your parents to help you on this one and see if they can come up with any more ideas. Here's another example: When you are riding in a car and see a green light, you have faith that the other cars will stop at their red light. Sometimes they don't, but we always believe they will.
